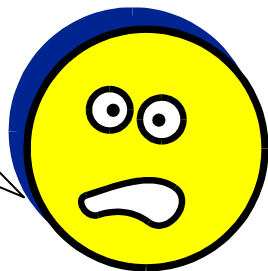


# The two times table
