

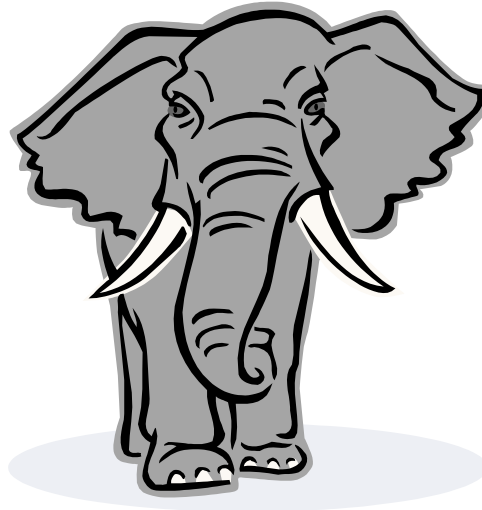
Vowels
